10.1 Qualification for the position:

- 10.1.1 She must be a graduate or above in journalism or mass communication from a recognized institution of higher learning.
- 10.1.2 She must be a visionary, creative, with a good track record of experience and diligence in leadership.
- 10.1.3 She must be willing and ready to commit her time to the organization.
- 10.1.4 She must be conversant and articulate with social, political, economical and cultural issues, which have impact on women's efforts to emancipate them.
- 10.1.5 She must be politically nonpartisan and should not in any way use, involve or cause the Association to be used or involved in political parties' politics.

10.2 Powers and mandate of the Chairperson:

- 10.2.1 She will chair all meetings of the Governing Board and General Meetings.
- 10.2.2 She will represent the Association in various for within and outside the country.
- 10.2.3 She will be the banner holder of the collective image of the Association.
- 10.2.4 The Chairperson shall be elected in the Annual General Meeting after every three years by simple majority votes of the members who are eligible to vote and can be re elected within the maximum of two terms.
- 10.2.5 In case of her absence in any meeting, which she is mandated to chair, the meeting shall elect an interim Chairperson whose mandate shall be to chair that meeting only
